Directions to Milton Keynes Theatre

By car: For Sat Nav's use the street address (Marlborough Gate) instead of the post code. If you are travelling via the M1, please leave the motorway at junction 14. For the A5, please leave at the junction for Central Milton Keynes leading on to the A509 Portway.

There are several car parks around the theatre. Charges apply and we advise using the RingGo app to pay. All car parks, except John Lewis are free after 6pm. By train: Buses will take you from Milton Keynes Central Rail to bus stops outside the theatre on Midsummer Boulevard. There is also a taxi rank outside the train station.
