

## Richmond Theatre



Richmond Theatre, designed by Frank Matcham, opened in 1899 and continues to attract first-class companies and famous names including Andrew Scott, Jonathan Pryce, Sir Ian McKellen, and comedians such as Jimmy Carr, Nina Conti, and Al Murray. We are primarily a playhouse but also host musicals, stand-up, ballet, opera and pantomime across the year. The venue has also been used in many a TV and film productions including, Downton Abbey, Ted Lasso, and Killing Eve just to name a few. ATG continues to update and upgrade the building, the last major refurbishment began in 2019 and saw the front and back of house areas being refreshed including vital repairs to the roof, improvement of heating, and redecorated bar areas, then in 2022 All Back of House Dressing rooms were upgraded.

### How to get to Richmond Theatre

#### Trains /Buses

Trains run regularly to Richmond station from London Waterloo and the journey takes 20-25 minutes. The London Overground service runs east to Stratford via north London, and District Line tubes also run from Richmond Station. Richmond is served by numerous bus routes, connecting with Kingston, Ealing, Twickenham, Teddington and Hampton Court.

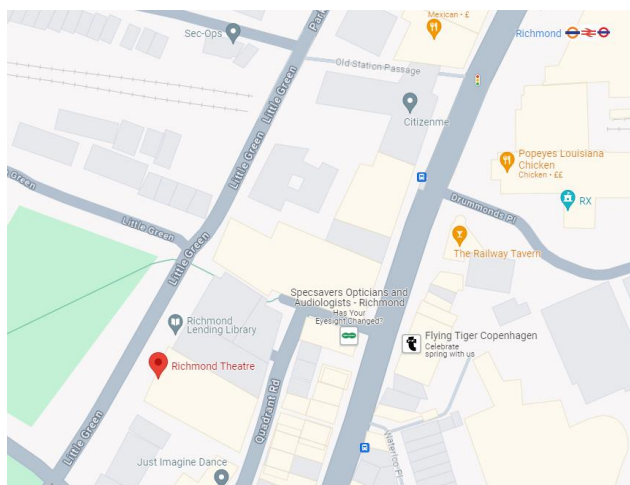
#### Parking

Parking is not permitted at the rear of the theatre before 6.30pm unless in the specified metered bays. The local traffic wardens are **very** diligent. The nearest pay and display car parks are the Old Deer Park car park (off the A316) and the NCP car park adjacent to Richmond Station. Blue badge holders may park on Richmond Green and Little Green and in marked bays at the rear of the theatre at any time without payment, if the badge is correctly displayed, and the stay is no longer than the allowed 3 hours.

#### Arriving for your Interview at Stage Door

Stage Door is located on Quadrant Road and the Main Entrance is on the Little Green. When arriving for an interview please come to the Stage Door on Quadrant Road.
