The Palace Theatre & Opera House are owned and operated by The Ambassador Theatre Group. #### Entrance:

There are black doors, next to the door is an intercom. Use the intercom to gain access to the theatre. You will then be asked to head straight down the ginnel and enter stage door. You will then sign in and await your interviewer's arrival.

#### Directions:



The nearest train station is Oxford Road (situated directly opposite the theatre). Piccadilly train station is only 0.3 miles from the theatre (15 min walk). The nearest tram stop is St Peters Square (7 min walk).
