As a Product Designer you will be working within an agile environment, applying your product design knowledge to real-world digital products and services. This role is based in ATG's Head Office in London's West End and embedded in our broader Product & Engineering Teams.

You'll report to the Head of Product Design and work day-to-day within your product team and the rest of the design team. You will also work closely with the wider business teams such as the Ticketing teams, Food & Beverage teams, Marketing teams and other ATG stakeholders to build customer-centric experiences.

This is a pivotal role to shape the user experience and digital branding for the UK's largest musical theatre ticketing company ATG Entertainment— both for our audiences as well as the producers we serve. We want you to drive product design delivery across multiple products by systematically approaching visual design, passion for aesthetics, familiarity with the latest accessibility standards, and excellent leadership and interpersonal abilities.

Key responsibilities

As a Design system Manager you will demonstrate your ability to:

- Evolve ATG's DLS to create an efficient, scalable and modern system that aligns with each of ATG's brand identities
- Work with the wider design teams to co-create and maintain a cohesive design systems approach and libraries
- Collaborate with Engineering counterparts to establish how we successfully maintain and grow our token architecture to meet the specific needs of each of our brands
- Ensure our products are accessible, inclusive and localised following our standards.
- Develop and document comprehensive design system guidelines and best practices.
- Continuously optimise our UI and design system through iterative testing and data.
- Collaborate with multi-disciplinary teams to ensure designs meet marketing, customer and technical needs.
- A strong communicator, with the ability to liaise with different stakeholders to understand their roadmaps and requirements, and influence them with clear rationale and insights in your designs.
