The Casual Technician Role

Casual technicians work as part of a team reporting to the Technical Manager. You'll work closely the Chief Technician and Senior Technicians and with visiting companies, touring teams and contractors as well as other ATG Entertainment venue staff.

Working as part of the venue Technical Team you will support all productions and events programmed, ensuring their technical requirements are achieved. This role provides a professional, enabling and efficient service for all customers and visitors to ATG Entertainment's venues.

Key responsibilities

- Welcome and assist visiting production technical staff and companies to the venue, ensuring they are treated appropriately and always as an important and valued client.
- Support the full-time technical staff in ensuring the smooth and efficient running of fit-ups, shows and get outs, in line with company policy, current health and safety legislation and the requirements of the visiting production or event.
- Take pride in your working environment at all times ensuring that work areas are clean, tidy and safe. Under the direction of the full-time technical staff assist as required in the inspection, servicing and maintenance of the stage machinery and production equipment.
- Work safely at all times, proactively identify risks to yourself, other colleagues and customers health, safety or security and take appropriate actions to keep everyone safe.
- Implement and comply with the company Health & Safety Policy, maintaining the safest possible environment for your colleagues, visiting companies and customers.
- Attend training as required developing skills and knowledge relevant to the role.
- Work collaboratively as a team member, working well with others to ensure all required tasks are completed. Maintain a can do, professional attitude.
- Proactively identify tasks which need to be done and take responsibility for completing them

- Experience with single purchase counterweight flying. Including fit ups, get outs and show flying.
- To be able to fault find and problem solve where required to ensure the production runs as smoothly as possible
- Experienced in safety legislation, implementation of safe systems and developing safety culture.
- Experience of working alongside or part of large-scale touring productions and working within commercial receiving theatre, music venues and cooperate events.
- Ability to problem solve and find creative solutions within budget constraints.
- Practical knowledge of Theatre techniques, rigging, terminology and stagecraft.
- Excellent time keeping.
- Proactive approach to work, self-starter with initiative and experience of managing own time effectively.
- A commitment to customer care.
- Dedicated and hard-working.
- Physically able to lift and move technical equipment and scenic items safely and sensibly
- Working knowledge of current Health & Safety Regulations.
- An ability to work flexible hours including evenings and weekends.
